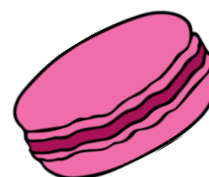
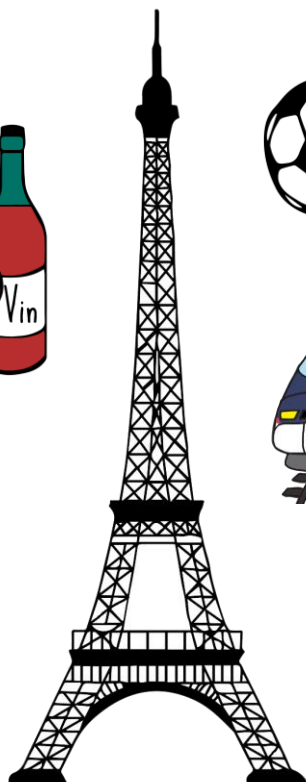
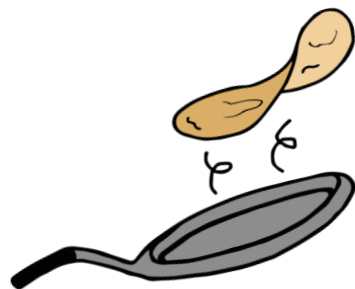
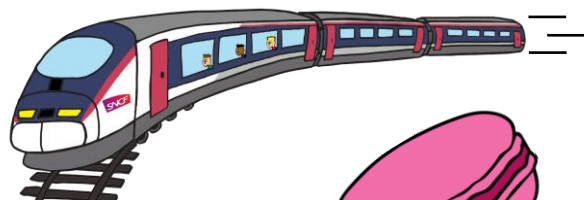
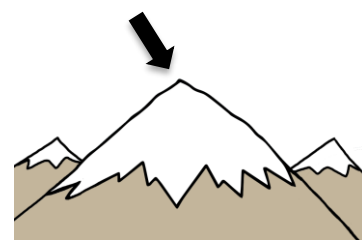
L.O: Discover France and its culture

- France has the highest mountain in Western Europe. It is called "Mont Blanc" in the French Alps.

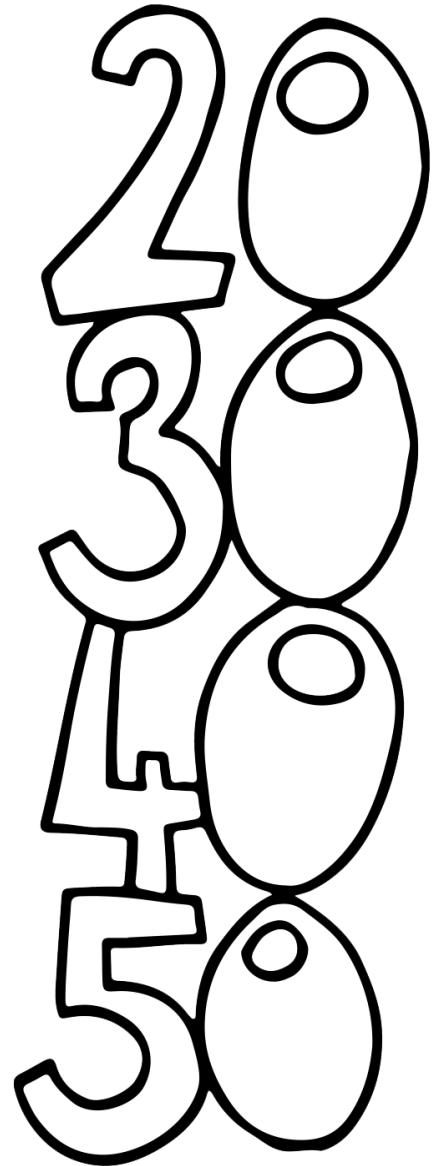
