

How you can support your child with their learning:

- ✦ Listen to your child read daily reading the entire book for those on book bands and 20 minutes per day in year 2 and spend time discussing the text.
- ✦ Visit the library and embrace ALL books.
- ✦ Practise their spelling for a few minutes daily.
- ✦ Help your child learn their KIRFS (Key Instant Recall Facts) for maths.
- ✦ Enjoy spending time with your child doing their home learning.
- ✦ Support their independence in all areas, this can range from carrying their own bag to you watching as they research for homework on the internet.
- ✦ Use lots of different sources of information e.g. books, the internet, other people.
- ✦ Children should have their PE kit in school every day.
- ✦ Outdoor learning - currently every Wednesday.

English

We will be using computers to help us research alongside a strong focus on how to keep ourselves and others safe online and why it matters.




Art and DT

To support the focus on recycling and protecting the environment for us and other living things we will be creating art using recycling to collage. We will also be using recycling to create a Ferris Wheel in DT.



Science
