Only two weeks left until the end of term, where has the time suddenly gone? We have several activities planned over the next two weeks – please check the diary dates at the end of this newsletter to keep track of what is happening and when.

WHOLE SCHOOL PTFA TRIP

The school trip, organised and paid for by the fabulous PTFA, is on Monday 12th July. We have the whole park to ourselves and we are scheduled to enter the park at 9.30am so please could parents drop children off in the car park between 9.15am and 9.30am to allow us to take registers before we enter. If the later drop off is a problem, I will ensure that a member of staff is there from 8.50am (probably me) to allow for this but the later drop off is preferred as there will be less hanging around.

Collection will also be from the Park at 3pm. Again, if this is a problem, a member of staff will wait with any children but please make every effort to collect at 3pm.

- Animal talks have been arranged for each class and there will be various other activities for the children to do throughout the day.
- Children can wear own clothes on their bottom half but please wear the blue PE t-shirts and the blue school sweatshirts/cardi/hoodie so that children can be easily spotted.
- Packed lunch, snacks and drinks must be brought in a rucksack but please do not send any other school bits in the bags.
- A coat should also be brought, as showers are always likely!
- If it looks like it will be sunny, sunhats should be worn as we will be outside most of the day and sun cream applied before drop-off.
- PE kits will be sent home Friday so that they can wear their PE top to the Wildlife Park and, to make things easier on Tuesday, children can come to school in their PE kit ready for sports day.

SPORTS DAY

This will take place on the afternoon of Tuesday 13th July. Please can all children wear their PE kit to school on that day. In previous years children have sat in their colour teams but to keep bubble-crossing to a minimum we will be having the children sitting in their classes. We will sit the children toward the far end where there is a large tree to provide some shelter.

Spectators: spectators can assemble themselves in the usual space along the track (not on the hedge side). This will allow free movement of the children along the hedge side of the field to and from their races. Spectators will need to bring their own picnic rug or folding chairs as we will not be bringing school furniture up to the field. Groups are allowed to assemble outdoors with up to 30 in a group. Please ensure, when you arrive that you ensure that you are spread out enough to be compliant with government guidelines.
