Dear Parents

Every class has settled back into the routine nicely: some as the older children in their class; some in their new class. I have visited all the classes and seen happy children engaged in meaningful learning activities.

We have been reminding children of our learning characters: Betty Bee, Olive Owl, Samuel Squirrel and Wilbur Woodpecker and how their characteristics help them become good learners. These are the qualities that we promote in all our classes – all we ask of any child is that they do their best and try hard. We do not want children to be worried about who is better or worse at reading, spelling, maths, PE etc. Praising learning behaviours is our way of doing this and we would like parents to also reflect this at home as well. The end of the week certificates are designed specifically to show the children that this is what drives the school and good learning behaviour is what we are promoting.

DROP OFF

Drop off at the gates to the lane (from School Lane and from the Church side) is continuing to be a success. Please remember that there will not be any adults supervising out there until 8.50am so please do not leave children on their own before this time. Similarly, at 9.00am staff will be returning to the classroom so there will also be no-one to supervise, so children must be brought to the office and they will be taken to their class. To avoid congestion at the small gate, could I kindly ask parents to move back from the gate once they have dropped off to allow for others to get in. We need to remember that some families are still quite cautious about crowded areas.

HARVEST

I have arranged to hold a small Harvest Celebration at The Beacon Baptist Church on Wednesday 29th September at 1.30pm. Each class will do a small piece for you – all parents are welcome to attend. There will be refreshments afterwards – very kindly organised by The Beacon.

We will collect the items as part of the assembly so children can bring any items in on the day. They take all tinned and dried goods that are in date. Other items they take are toilet rolls, nappies, personal hygiene products, household cleaning products and pet food.
